#### RECONCILIATION MONDAY

Each parish in the Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens, along with the Diocese of Rockville Centre and the Archdiocese of New York, will have priests available in every Church to hear confessions on Monday, March 25th, 2024 of Holy Week.

It is hoped that in the New York area all Catholics will have the opportunity to come to confession in any Church.

Here at St Clare, Fr. Kingsley and Fr. John will hear confessions after the morning Mass, in the afternoon from 2pm to 4pm in the Rectory Office, and in the evening from 6pm to 8pm during Eucharistic Adoration. We hope that these various times will allow every parishioner (including children) to come and celebrate the Sacrament of Penance before Easter.

#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

<u>Abstinence:</u> The Church Requires all the faithful who have reached their 14th year of age to abstain totally from meat on all the Fridays of Lent.

<u>Fasting:</u> All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the fasting regulation on Good Friday. This involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken at 2 other occasions in the day.


