My dear Parishioners,

I am filled with pride and joy that our beloved Saint Clare Church is now in her 100th year of continuous ministry to the peoples of Rosedale, Laurelton, and beyond. The planning committee, chaired by Mrs. Deborah Wright and myself, have been hard at work planning various socials, liturgies, and fundraisers to mark this auspicious milestone. You will find in this week's bulletin a calendar of events for the reminder of this centennial year culminating with our Dinner Dance Gala scheduled for Saturday, August 3rd, at Coral House in Baldwin, New York. I have, in these last few days, petitioned a number of my priest-colleagues to purchase tickets and take out journal ads. My mother, Mrs. Kingsley, has already reserved a table, if not two, to celebrate with her closest friends! It is in the spirit of the 100th Anniversary that I pose a "big ask" or challenge to you. This past weekend, the clergy and I announced the opening of the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal. The appeal supports the various ministerial and charitable initiatives of the Brooklyn Diocese, namely Catholic Charities, Catholic Migration Services, Futures in Education, the Bishop Mugavero Residence for Retired Priests to name a few. Parishes are asked to raise a certain amount which goes to the Diocese, anything raised above said amount is returned to the parish for her needs. This year, Saint Clare is tasked with raising \$55, 051 for the Diocese. We have, in years past met and exceeded our goal by some four to five thousand dollars. I would like to propose an additional parish goal of \$25, 000.

The parochial goal will tackle two major projects here at home, the first being the complete overhaul and renovation of the auditorium sound system. We have all attended functions there, whether plays, shows, presentations, meetings and the like where the common refrain is often, "I can't hear Father?!" or "What did she say, can she repeat herself?" Recently, at our last Women's Day Brunch those in the back of the auditorium could not enjoy the dramatized presentation of Shirley Chisholm's life as the actress' words were barely audible to them. The second project is the creation of an emergency building fund. In addition, to the church, our parish includes a school, a former convent, a rectory, and an annex. All of which are utilized, and all of which are beginning to show their age. I suspect that in the next few years, I, or my successor the 14th pastor, would have to embark on a capital campaign to address some structural issues, namely the church roof and the school cafeteria. I know it's a big ask, but one I am committed to as well. It is a drop in the bucket I will personally pledge \$150 a month to the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal to make these goals a reality.

And please know, there are other gift-giving opportunities for this centennial year, a "smaller ask" if you will. One parishioner, Mrs. Allison Attong-Rogers, has donated a beautiful icon of Saints Francis and Clare, which will soon hang in the back of church near our patroness' statue. To beautify our worship here at Saint Clare's, I am asking parishioners and societies if they would be interested in sponsoring new priests' and deacons' vestments for Sunday and weekday Masses. Thus far, the Soon Family has donated new chasubles, and the Rosary Society will donate a set of Marian vesture. If you are interested helping us with this, feel free to set up an appointment to see me with the office manager in the days ahead.

I thank you in advance for your profound generosity to this community of Saint Clare that we call home.


