
THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

The celebration of Christ's resurrection continues with the feast of the Divine Mercy, which recognizes that God's love and mercy will endure forever, and overcome sin that separates us from Him. In the 1930s, Jesus appeared to St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, and directed her to promote His Divine Mercy worldwide.

St. John Paul II canonized St. Faustina on May 1, 2000. Five days later the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

This year, consider praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy "for those who have died because of the coronavirus and for their loved ones, for those struggling with loneliness, anxiety and financial / job concerns, and for those who despair of finding God's mercy.

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and the whole world.



THE ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL 2024

Each year St. Clare Church and the Diocese of Brooklyn engage in the Annual Catholic Appeal which supports Catholic programs throughout Brooklyn and Queens and affects the lives of countless individuals and families living in our neighborhoods and benefiting our parish.

How Does Our Parish Benefit? In order for our parish to function, we need well-trained priests and deacons who can celebrate the sacraments and administer the parish. Without the \$2.5 Million from the **Appeal** allocated to vocations, we would not have the clergy our parish needs.

The Appeal provides funding that supports every parish religious education program as well as tuition assistance to those seeking Catholic Education at Catholic Academies and Schools. Over \$1.8 million from the **Appeal** is invested in the faith of our children in addition to also providing adult faith formation. Instruction programs for lay people, including those in our own parish, provide training in ministries such as Eucharistic Ministers or prepare others for sacraments.
