We, the undersigned, represent Saint Clare Catholic Church, the third oldest Christian house of worship in Rosedale, New York. We are writing on behalf of clergy, staff, and parishioners as we embark on our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

We have come a long way. It was in 1924, our first pastor, the Reverend Joseph Goeller celebrated the first Mass for parishioners in a former firehouse on Brookville Boulevard. The young priest had been tasked by the third Bishop of Brooklyn, the Most Reverend Thomas Molloy, with establishing a new parish in what was then a distant, far-flung, and rural corner of Queens County. Three short years later, the cornerstone was laid for the magnificent edifice we worship in today. Some twenty years later, the parish school was opened which continues to this present hour to educate children from Rosedale and beyond in the ways of reading, writing, arithmetic, and faith. The good that has happened here at Saint Clare could not have happened with the aid and goodwill of so many in the surrounding community.

We thank you for your support and most especially your prayers, as we celebrate this great milestone. Many events have been planned to commemorate our anniversary. The highlight will be our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner Dance which will take place on Saturday, August 3, 2024, 7 PM, at Coral House in Baldwin, New York. If you wish to grace us with your presence a dinner ticket costs \$175, while a table reservation for 10 people costs \$1,750. A commemorate journal will be distributed at our Dinner Dance that evening. May we ask in your kindness to take a journal advertisement in support of our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. 
