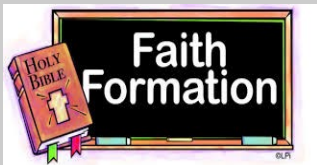

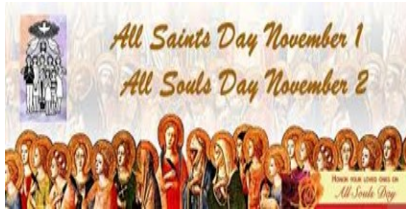

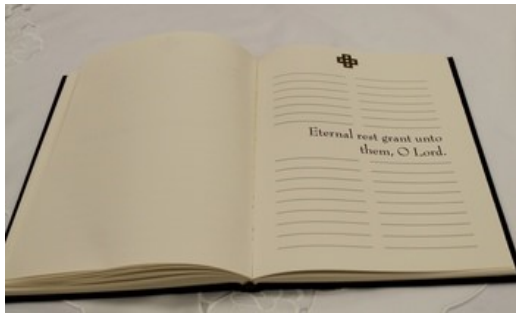
Lord, Teach me to be patient with life, with people, and with myself.
